STOP ONE

STOP TWO

Jesus ate the Last Supper with his friends.

It was a very special meal.

Can you think of a special meal you were at?

Every time people have Holy Communion in church they remember that meal.

Draw some bread in box 2.



STOP THREE

Some people did not like Jesus.
They told lies about him.
They said he had to die. Soldiers
nailed him to a cross. Jesus died.

How do you think his friends felt?

Draw two lines to make a cross
shape in box 3.

STOP FOUR

Jesus' body was wrapped up in a cloth and put in a tomb (or cave). A big stone was rolled in front of the tomb and two soldiers were on guard.

Do you know the name of that day?

Why do you think it is called that name?

Draw the tomb with the stone in front of it.



STOP FIVE

Three days later two women
who were friends of Jesus
went to the tomb.

When they arrived the stone
was rolled away.

Jesus' body was not there.

An angel told them Jesus was
alive.

How do you think they felt?
Draw their faces in box 5.



STOP SIX

The women ran to tell their friends. Over the next few days they met Jesus who was alive. They celebrated.

That's why we celebrate at Easter time.

Jesus was dead and then was alive.

The hollow Easter Egg reminds us of the empty tomb.

Draw an Easter egg in the last box on your page.
